Purpose


To provide an outline of the Topic summary of the Census – Ethnicity, Language and Religion.

Ethnic Group


In 2021, 93.1% (286,955) of usual residents in Doncaster identified their ethnic group within the high-level "White" category, a decrease from 95.3% (288,066) in the 2011 Census. In the Yorkshire and Humber region, 85.4% identified as "White", a decrease from 88.8% in the 2011 Census.

As part of the "White" ethnic group, 86.6% (266,879) of the total population in Doncaster identified their ethnic group as "English, Welsh, Scottish, Northern Irish or British"; this is a continued decrease from 91.8% (277,740) in 2011, and from 96.5% (276,828) who identified this way in 2001. In the Yorkshire and Humber region, 80.9% identified as "English, Welsh, Scottish, Northern Irish or British", a decrease from 85.8% in 2011 and from 91.7% in 2001.

The next most common high-level ethnic group was "Asian, Asian British or Asian Welsh" accounting for 2.9% (9,086) of the overall population, up from 2.5% (7,614 people). In Yorkshire and Humber, "Asian, Asian British or Asian Welsh" accounts for 8.9%, up from 7.3% in 2011.



Across the 19 ethnic groups, the largest percentage point increase in Doncaster was seen in the number of people identifying through the "Other White" category (5.7%, 17,534 in 2021, up from 2.8%, 8,556 in 2011). The numbers for "Irish", "Caribbean" and "Chinese" have all reduced in Doncaster between 2011 and 2021; "Irish" has reduced to 999 in 2021, down from 1,183 in 2011, "Caribbean" has reduced to 672 in 2021, down from 778 in 2011, and "Chinese" has reduced to 1,031 in 2021 down from 1,121 in 2011. In Yorkshire and Humber, "Other White" is also the category which has the biggest percentage point increase; 3.8% in 2021, up from 2.5% in 2011.



Large changes were also seen in the numbers of people identifying their ethnic group as "Any other ethnic group" (1.1%, 3,294 in 2021, up from 0.3%, 833 in 2011), and "African" (0.8%, 2,527 in 2021, up from 0.4%, 1,309). In the Yorkshire and Humber region, "Pakistani" has increased (5.4% in 2021, up from 4.3% in 2011), and "Any other ethnic group" has also increased (1% in 2021, up from 0.4% in 2011).

In Doncaster, 5.0% (6,775) of households consisted of members identifying with two or more different ethnic groups, an increase from 4.0% (5,097) in 2011. In Yorkshire and Humber, 6.5% of households had members of two or more ethnic groups, an increase from 5.7% in 2011.

The most noticeable increase has been in the number of people identifying their ethnic group as "Other ethnic group", specifically in the Hexthorpe & Balby North (up 2.8 percentage points), Town (up by 3.6) and Wheatley Hills & Intake (up by 2.5).

Language

In 2021, 92.8% (276,387) of usual residents, aged three years and over, had English as a main language (down from 95.9%, or 290,756, in 2011). In the Yorkshire and Humber region, 93.2% of usual residents had English as a main language, down from 94.1% in 2011.

In 2021, a further 5.6% (16,547) of the overall population of Doncaster were proficient in English but did not speak it as their main language. In Yorkshire and Humber, it was a further 5.1% of the population. There are two key Wards where a significant proportion of the population (>10%) do not speak English – Town Ward and Hexthorpe and Balby North Ward.

The most common main languages, other than English, were Polish (2.2%, 6,495), Romanian (1.8%, 5,428), Kurdish (0.2%, 699), Slovak (0.2%, 689) and Turkish (0.2%, 631). The largest increase was for people who specified Romanian as a main language, who accounted for over 1.8% of usual residents in 2021 (5,428 people).



Religion

The religion question is voluntary; 94.7% (291,636) of usual residents answered the question in 2021, an increase from 93.2% (281,681) in 2011. In Yorkshire and Humber, 94.2% answered the question in 2021, an increase from 93.3% in 2011.

Just over half of Doncaster residents described themselves as "Christian" (50.9%, 156,747 people), a 15.0 percentage point decrease from 65.9% (199,320) in 2011. In Yorkshire and Humber, 44.9% of the population described themselves as "Christian", down from 59.5% in 2011. "No religion" was the second most common response, increasing by 12.0 percentage points to 39.8% (122,645) from 24.4% (73,656) in 2011. In Yorkshire and Humber, 39.4% of the population recorded as "No religion", up from 25.9% in 2011.

There were increases in the number of people who described themselves as "Muslim" (6,898, 2.2% in 2021, up from 4,990, 1.7% in 2011) and "Hindu" (1,294, 0.4% in 2021, up from 881, 0.3% in 2011).
